Sermon Points:

<u>Morning:</u> What Christ Has Done 1. The Living Parable 2. The Living Principle Afternoon: The Temptation of Presumption 1. God's Gracious Blessings 2. God's Admonitions 3. God's Faithfulness **<u>Prayers & Intercessions</u>**: Presbytery's focus is Riverside ARP Church in Cambridge, ON. They are without a minister, so let us make this a matter of our prayers for this congregation.

Concerning the Lord's Supper: The Lord's Supper is about communion in Christ with his body, the Church. To our visitors we do not close the table; however, we do ask that you heed the warning and invitation given at the serving of the elements and affirm these five points, so that your participation will be one of faith and knowledge in Christ:

(1) Do you confess that you are a sinner in the sight of God; that you deserve His punishment; that you are unable to save yourself; and that you are without hope of salvation apart from God's love and mercy?

(2) Do you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God and the Saviour of sinners and are you trusting in Him alone for your salvation?

(3) Do you accept the Bible as the inspired, inerrant Word of God, and the only perfect rule of faith and life?

(4) Do you rely upon the Holy Spirit so that you can live all of life as a Christian, following the example set by Jesus Christ?

(5) Are you a baptised communicant member in good standing of a church that teaches and upholds the previous four affirmations?
